

iTech Boot Camp! Using iTechnology as Evidence-based Practice to Meet the Learning and Behavioral Needs for Students with Autism Spectrum Disorder

This multi day *iTechnology Camp* will give participants a wealth of information and resources for using iPads, iPods and iPhones to meet the learning and behavioral needs of students with ASD, and most importantly, to increase their independent functioning. Hardware, accessories, and access tips and tools for making iTechnology systems user friendly for both students and adults will be shared and explored.

The primary evidence-based practice focus areas for this training will include using iTechnology for video-modeling, social narratives, visual schedules, visual timers, visual organization and visual directions for any task or activity including self-regulation, self-help, behavior management, and academics. *Numerous apps* will be thoroughly reviewed, and participants will have the opportunity to design and create strategies and supports for their specific needs.

Participants will leave this training with numerous strategies for incorporating previously identified “low tech” visual supports into “high tech” iTechnology systems, to teach a broad range of skills for students with ASD.
